#### **Background**

Large Cardamom - Amomum subulatum (family Zingiberaceae) is one of the main perennial cash crop largely cultivated in the state of Sikkim, West Bengal (Darjeeling-Kalimpong hills) and Arunachal Pradesh. As a high value-low volume crop, Large Cardamom, a boon to mountain population, is usually cultivated in the agro-forestry system and known to contribute to the mitigation of climate change impacts due to its higher primary productivity and carbon fixation rates. Its ecological flexibility, social adaptability and mountain specific niche has made it an important element in mountain ecosystem providing livelihood options. In addition, it is less labour-intensive and found to be non-nutrients exhaustive system compared to other crops in the region. The increasing demand for large cardamom in the local and global market in the recent past strongly motivated farmers to bring more land under large cardamom cultivation. At the same time the high fluctuation in yield and fall in prices has driven farmers to explore more sustainable modes of large cardamom production. The large cardamom sector faces various challenges, such as increased exposure to climate impacts, low economic opportunities, lack of access to finance and the global market, lack of initiatives for value addition and increased competition with substitute products. Considering these challenges, there is a need to strengthen best crop management practices i.e. pre and post harvest techniques, value chain development and management, and develop stakeholder's network and market linkages.

Recently, the MoEF&CC has launched an initiative for Green Skill Development in the environment and forest sector in consultation with the National Skill Development Agency to enable India's youth to get gainful employment and/or self-employment, called the Green Skill Development Programme (GSDP). The programme endeavours to develop green

skilled workers having technical knowledge and commitment to sustainable development of the country. Realizing this and strengthening the large cardamom farming skills among youths, certification course under GSDP on "large cardamom farming and livelihood enhancement" is prerequisite in the Khangchendzonga Landscape, India in collaboration with KLCDI-India tasks.

Realizing the importance of large cardamom farming especially in the KL-India for ecosystem management and livelihood, the skill of local youths may be encouraged which may support them to generate self-employment and/or entrepreneurship in the field of large cardamom based niche products. In this regard, a three weeks "Certificate Course on Large Cardamom Farming & Livelihood Enhancement" is proposed under GSDP in support with KLCDI-India programme by the Sikkim Regional Centre of the Institute during 11 - 24 December, 2020 (112 hrs). The main aim of the course is to provide advance knowledge of large cardamom farming and value chain, and soft skills to marketing services.

The course aims to engage interested and/or progressive youths from Sikkim and Darjeeling-Kalimpong Himalayan region through skill and capacity building on large cardamom based enterprises. The following major topics will be covered during the event:

- Agronomic practices of Large cardamom farming
- Organic farming of large cardamom
- Post harvest technologies
- · Agro-forestry and pollination friendly farming
- Large cardamom value chain and marketing
- Encourage youths towards self-employment and/or entrepreneurship in large cardamom farming
